Ballot Drop Off Information for City of Oakdale

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR VOTERS: To help slow the spread of COVID-19, the governor of California has signed an executive order declaring the November 3, 2020 Presidential General Election all mail with limited in-person voting. Shortly after that, two bills were passed: AB 860, declaring an all-mail format for this election, and SB 423, declaring that in-person voting be made available on a limited basis.

WHAT HAS CHANGED: Starting October 5, all registered active voters will receive a ballot in the mail. Ballots can be returned by mail in the postage-paid envelope provided, or they can be dropped in one of the ballot drop boxes throughout the county where ballots will be collected by Registrar of Voters staff. In-person satellite offices will be available throughout the county from October 31 through Election Day, November 3, for voters to receive a replacement vote by mail ballot, use an accessible device to assist the voter or receive language assistance.
