Man Arrested at Early Morning Disturbance

Oakdale, CA – Early morning disturbance leads to arrest of 19 year old man for disorderly conduct and assault on a police officer.

On October 2nd, 2018 at 6:25 a.m., Oakdale Police received reports of three subjects causing a disturbance in the 300 block of S. 3rd Avenue. Upon arrival, a police sergeant observed three males and one female were having a loud argument in public. The argument turned physical when one of the males pushed another male. The police sergeant on scene ordered the men to break it up when one of the subjects, identified as Henry Deleon, 19 years, a known criminal street gang member, turned towards the officer and yelled profanity, and at one point, attempted to physically assault the police sergeant.

A struggle ensued between Deleon and the police sergeant as they went to the ground. Deleon was quickly subdued and restrained in handcuffs. Both the officer and Deleon sustained abrasions and bruises as a result of the altercation. Henry Deleon, 19 years, had obvious symptoms of intoxication and was arrested for 647(f) PC – Disorderly Conduct, 243 (b) PC – Battery on a Police Officer and 186.22 PC Participation in a Criminal Street Gang. Deleon was booked into the Stanislaus County Public Safety Center.
