Oakdale Man Arrested in Connection with Deadly Stabbing

Oakdale, CA – Oakdale Police are investigating a stabbing homicide at an apartment complex in the 100 block of S. 6th Avenue.

This morning at approximately 10:48 a.m., Oakdale Police received several 911 calls regarding multiple stabbing victims in the 100 block of S. 6th Avenue. Oakdale Police arrived on scene and located multiple injured victims. When they arrived, the suspect, 28-year-old George Grass of Oakdale, fled and barricaded himself inside an upstairs apartment. Officers surrounded the building and repeatedly ordered Grass to come out. Officers, utilized less than lethal munitions to disable surveillance cameras posted outside the man's apartment. The suspect threw some type of firework explosive out of an upstairs window at officers at the rear of the apartment.

The Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department assisted with deputies and a SWAT team. After approximately an hour of negotiating with the suspect, Grass surrendered to officers without further incident.

After lifesaving attempts by officers and paramedics, a 37-year-old male stabbing victim succumbed to his injuries at the scene. Two female victims in their twenties were transported to local area hospitals for non-life-threatening injuries.

George Grass, 28 years of age, was arrested at the scene in connection with the ongoing homicide investigation.
