Councilmember Eligibility, Requirements & Public Disclosure

To be eligible to be appointed to the Oakdale City Council, you Candidates must be 18 years of age, reside within the corporate limits of the City of Oakdale, be registered to vote in the City of Oakdale at the time the application is issued and not have been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor related to financial impropriety.

If you are appointed to the vacant position by a majority vote of the City Council, your term will expire after the results of the General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 have been certified.

Once a Council Member application is filed with the City, it is a public record available to the public.

Please note City Council members are elected officers identified in Government Code Section 87200 and are required to file statements of economic interests with the City Clerk's Office. Copies of the statements of economic interest filed by the above elected officers may be obtained by visiting the office of the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) or the City Clerk. NOTICE OF INTENTION TO FILL A VACANCY FOR MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL BY APPOINTMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Oakdale will accept applications from qualified registered voters for appointment to the City Council to fill the vacancy created by the appointment of Council Member Cherilyn Bairos to the position of Mayor, effective January 7, 2021.

The term of this Council seat is from the date of appointment through the date the results of the General Municipal Election on Tuesday, November 8, 2022 have been certified.

Candidates must be 18 years of age, reside within the corporate (city) limits of the City of Oakdale, be registered to vote in the City of Oakdale at the time the application is issued and not have been convicted of a felony, or misdemeanor relating to financial impropriety.

Fully completed applications must be returned by 4:00 p.m., Friday, February 5, 2021. Applicants may be invited for an oral interview before the city council.

The City Council will interview candidates separately and each applicant will have the opportunity to present their qualifications and discuss their candidacy with the City Council.

At a Special meeting of the City Council on Wednesday, February 10, 2021, at 6:00 p.m., each invited applicant will be asked to make a 3-minute presentation to the City Council. The applicant may then be asked to respond to questions the City Council may have regarding their presentation or application. The order in which the applicants will make their presentation will be determined by a random draw of all the applicant's names. This random draw will take place at the beginning of the Special City Council meeting on February 10, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

The City Council may make a decision at the special meeting or may direct staff to place the matter on a future agenda for action.
