Man Arrested for Prior Domestic Violence Incident during Traffic Stop

Oakdale, CA – An Oakdale man was arrested during a traffic stop yesterday for domestic violence charges stemming from a September 2nd incident.

On September 3, 2018 at 8:23 a.m. a citizen came to the Oakdale Police Department to report she was assaulted on September 2, 2018 by her ex-boyfriend, Nicholas Rojas Ramirez Jr., 54 years old who subsequently was arrested on multiple felony charges. The confidential victim alleged she and Rojas went to his residence where she was later held against her will, tortured and assaulted with a baseball bat. Rojas reportedly prevented the victim from calling for police emergency services by throwing her phone during the incident.

A warrant was issued for Ramirez's arrest as his whereabouts was unknown following the incident. Oakdale Police located Nicholas Rojas Ramirez Jr. on September 4th and he was taken into custody during a traffic stop. Ramirez was booked into the Stanislaus County Public Safety Center for alleged violations of 273.5 PC Domestic Violence / Strangulation, 207 PC Kidnapping, 245PC Assault with a Deadly Weapon, 422 PC Threats and 591 PC Disabling Phone during Emergency.

A search warrant was served on Ramirez's residence on September 4th related to the ongoing investigation. The case remains under active investigation.
