Traffic Stop Leads to Heroin Packaged For Sale

Oakdale, CA – Man arrested Friday afternoon with a package of heroin during a traffic stop near post office.

On Friday, August 4th, around 1:30 p.m., officers stopped a red Ford Taurus for an observed vehicle registration violation in the 100 block of California Ave. near the post office.

The driver of the vehicle, Brian Bockert, 40 years old, was found to be on probation from Tuolumne County for prior sales of narcotics. Bockert was searched per the terms of his probation and found to be in possession of approximately 10 grams of black tar heroin in a package. Evidence found in the vehicle appeared to indicate that Bockert may have been preparing to ship the narcotics to another person through the mail.

Bockert was arrested and booked into the Stanislaus County Jail for 11351 H&S - Narcotics Sales and Distribution and 1203.2A PC - Probation Violation.
