NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Municipal Election will be held in the City of Oakdale, County of Stanislaus, State of California, on the 5th day of November, 2019, for the purpose of submitting to the voters two ballot measures:

- (1) To approve an extension of the existing one-half cent transactions and use (sales) tax to fund Oakdale city services, including police, fire and emergency services, parks and sports field maintenance, youth, teen and senior services, support services and other general services. A majority vote is required for the passage of the ballot measure. The exact form of the measure to be voted upon shall appear on the ballot as follows:

To help prevent additional budget cuts and maintain City services, including police and fire protection, senior programs, and other general services, shall the City of Oakdale extend the existing ½ cent sales tax set to expire April 2020, for an additional eleven (11) years, with resident oversight and annual independent audits?	YES

- (2) To decide whether the office of the City Clerk should be an appointed position. A majority vote is required for the passage of the ballot measure. The exact form of the measure to be voted upon shall appear on the ballot as follows:

The deadline to submit rebuttals to arguments for and against must be submitted by August 2, 2019. Both arguments and rebuttals are to be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk, 280 North Third Avenue, Oakdale, California 95361.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that ballots from the November 5, 2019 Municipal Election are to be tallied and the canvass of the vote will be conducted at the Stanislaus County Elections Division (central counting place) at 1021 "I" Street, Suite 101, Modesto, California, commencing no later than 9:00 a.m., November 6, 2019. All proceedings at the central counting place are open to the public pursuant to Election Code 15204.
