Male Stabbed Multiple Times Behind Quik Stop

**Oakdale, CA** – Male stabbed multiple times in the early morning hours behind Quik Stop.

Early this morning, at around 1:20 a.m., officers responded to the Quik Stop business located at 630 East "F" Street for a report of a male who was stabbed multiple times in the parking lot in back of the business. Officers arrived on scene and located the victim who advised that the suspects, two Hispanic males in their 20's, assaulted him to the rear of the business and then fled on foot northbound on North 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.

The first suspect was described as having a red shirt and a mustache and the other was wearing a black shirt and black hat with eye glasses. The victim was transported to a local area hospital and treated and released for non-life threatening injuries.
