

**Subject:** Possible appointment of uncontested nominees to the offices of this

City that were to be elected on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 and cancelation of the General Municipal Election currently scheduled

for November 8, 2016.

#### I. BACKGROUND

At the close of the nomination period on August 12, 2016, only two individuals were nominated for the two "at large" City Council positions and one individual was nominated for the City Clerk position. The incumbent City Treasurer did not seek reelection, which extended the nomination period for the City Treasurer seat to August 17, 2016. At the close of the August 17, 2016 nomination period, only one candidate was nominated. Elections Code §10229 allows for appointment of those persons who have been nominated when there are not more candidates than offices to be elected.

Pursuant to §10229 of the Elections Code, the City Clerk submitted a Certification of the Facts to the City Council stating that there were not more candidates than offices to be elected. The Certification of the Facts is attached to the proposed resolution as Exhibit A. A Notice that there were not more candidates than offices to be elected was published in the *Modesto Bee* on Friday, August 19, 2016. City Council can adopt one of the following courses of action:

- 1) Appoint to the office the person(s) who has/have been nominated.
- 2) Appoint to the office an eligible elector if no one has been nominated.
- 3) Hold the election, if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

#### II. ANALYSIS

The offices up for election this election cycle are two at-large City Council seats, City Treasurer, and City Clerk. The offices of City Treasurer and City Clerk each have one nominee. There are two nominees for City Council's two open seats. As a result, each candidate is unopposed for their respective office.



## CITY OF OAKDALE CITY COUNCIL STAFF REPORT

SUBJECT: Possible appointment of the only nominees to the offices of this City that were to be elected

on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 and cancelation of the General Municipal Election currently

scheduled for November 8, 2016.

MEETING DATE: August 25, 2016

There is a nominee for each office, eliminating option two as an available course of action for the City Council. The Council may either appoint the nominated individuals to office under option one, or proceed with the election under option three. If by the 75<sup>th</sup> day before the municipal election (August 25, 2016), no person has been appointed to office, the election shall be held.

Adoption of the attached Resolution appoints Tom Dunlop and Richard Murdoch to the City Council, Kathy Teixeira to City Clerk, and Christine Sulhoff to City Treasurer. Each appointee will take office and serve exactly as if they were elected at the general municipal election. Each appointee's term will begin at the conclusion of the existing officers' terms and end in December 2020. The proposed Resolution cancels the November 8, 2016 election and requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus take all steps necessary to remove the election from the consolidated election scheduled for that date.

#### III. FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

There is a potential savings to the City of \$29,010 to \$48,350 by canceling the General Municipal Election scheduled for November 8, 2016.

#### IV. RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends the City Council adopt a Resolution appointing the current nominees to the offices of City Council, City Clerk and City Treasurer positions; cancelling the General Municipal Election currently scheduled for Tuesday, November 8, 2016; and requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus take all steps required to remove the election from the consolidated election scheduled for that date.

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKDALE

APPOINTING UNCONTESTED NOMINEES TO THE OFFICES OF CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK, AND CITY TREASURER; CANCELING THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION CURRENTLY SCHEDULED FOR NOVEMBER 8, 2016; AND REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS TAKE ALL STEPS REQUIRED TO REMOVE THE ELECTION SAID ELECTION FROM THE CONSOLIDATED ELECTION SCHEDULED FOR THAT DATE

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, as of the close of the nomination period on August 12, 2016, if there are not more candidates than offices to be elected, Section 10229 of the Elections Code allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:

- 1. Appoint to the office the person(s) who has/have been nominated.
- 2. Appoint to the office an eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
- 3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

**WHEREAS**, there are no other City offices to be filled at the November 8, 2016 election, and no City measure has qualified to be submitted to the voters at that election;

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk's Certification that there were not more candidates than offices to be elected, attached hereto as Exhibit A, was submitted to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, a notice that there were not more candidates than offices to be elected was published on August 19, 2016 in the Modesto Bee pursuant to Government Code Section 6061.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the **CITY COUNCIL** of the **CITY OF OAKDALE** does hereby resolve, declare, determine and order as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Pursuant to Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the following action is being taken:

The following persons are hereby appointed to the offices to which they were nominated:

**SECTION 2:** The election scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, is now canceled, the City Council's request to the Board of Supervisors to consolidate that election with the statewide election is hereby rescinded and the Board of Supervisors is hereby requested to direct the County Elections Offical to take all steps required to remove reference

to a general municipal election in the City of Oakdale from the ballot materials for such election and to otherwise implement the cancelation of said election with the cooperation and assistance of the City Clerk of the City of Oakdale.

**SECTION 3:** The persons appointed shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office.

**SECTION 4:** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION IS HEREBY ADOPTED at a special meeting of the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF OAKDALE held on the 25th day of August, 2016 by the following vote:

## CITY OF OAKDALE CERTIFICATE OF FACTS

I, Kathy Teixeira, City Clerk of the City Oakdale do hereby certify, pursuant to Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the following facts relating to the General Municipal Election to be held on November 8, 2016.

1. As of the close of the nomination period, the persons so nominated for the two at-large City Council positions are:

Tom Dunlop for City Council Member for the full term of four (4) years Richard Murdoch for City Council Member for the full term of four (4) years

2. As of the close of the nomination period, the person so nominated for City Clerk is:

Kathy Teixeira for City Clerk for the full term of four (4) years

3. As of the close of the nomination period, the person so nominated for City Treasurer is:

Christine Sulhoff for City Treasurer for the full term of four (4) years

Section 10229 of the Elections Code of the State of California allows one of the following courses of action to be taken by the City Council:

- 1. Appoint to the office the person(s) who has/have been nominated.
- 2. Appoint to the office an eligible voter if no one has been nominated.
- 3. Hold the election if either no one or only one person has been nominated.

There are no other City offices to be filled at the November 8, 2016 election, and no City measure has qualified to be submitted to the voters at that election.

A notice of these facts was published on August 19, 2016 in a newspaper of general circulation in the City pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code. The City Council will meet on August 25, 2016 to either make the appointment(s) or direct that the election be held. If, by the 75<sup>th</sup> day before the municipal election, no person has been appointed to the office(s) pursuant to (1) or (2) above, the election shall be held.

The person(s) appointed, if any, shall qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at a municipal election for the office. If the City Council makes an appointment pursuant to §10229 of the Elections Code, the City Clerk shall not accept for filing any statement of write-in candidacy which is submitted after the appointment is made.
